




Use AirPrint to print from your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch

Learn how to print from your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch to an AirPrint-enabled printer.

Before you begin

- Confirm that your printer supports AirPrint. Contact your printer's manufacturer for details.
- Make sure that your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch and your printer are connected to the same Wi-Fi network and that you're within range.

Print with AirPrint

1. Open the app that you want to print from.
2. To find the print option, tap the app's share icon —  or  — or tap **...**.
3. Scroll down and tap  or **Print**. If you can't find the print option, check the app's User Guide or Help section. Not all apps support AirPrint.
4. Tap **Select Printer** and choose an [AirPrint-enabled printer](#).
5. Choose the number of copies or other options, like which pages you want to print.
6. Tap **Print** in the upper-right corner.



View or cancel your print job

While printing, you can view your print jobs or cancel them through the App Switcher.

View a print job



To view a print job, [open the App Switcher](#), then tap Print Center.

Cancel a print job



To cancel a print job, [open the App Switcher](#), tap Print Center, then tap Cancel Printing.

AirPrint works with Wi-Fi or wired network connections. AirPrint devices connected to the USB port of an Apple AirPort Base Station or AirPort Time Capsule, or to your computer using Bluetooth connection, can't use AirPrint.

Print from iPad

Use AirPrint to print wirelessly to an AirPrint-enabled printer from apps such as Mail, Photos, and Safari. Many apps available on the App Store also support AirPrint.

iPad and the printer must be on the same Wi-Fi network. See the Apple Support article [About AirPrint](#).

Print a document

Tap , , or  (depending on the app you're using), then tap Print. (Swipe up if you don't see Print.)

See the status of a print job

[Open the App Switcher](#), then tap Print Center.

The badge on the icon shows how many documents are in the queue.

To cancel a print job, select it in Print Center, then tap Cancel Printing.
